### Footnotes

SLIGHT FEVER bumped lightly with MIAMI HAMMER at the start, shrugged it off and went on to assume a forward position, prompted the pacesetter from the two path, being mildly coaxed along to apply the pressure, continued along on the same scenario until leaving the three-eighths pole, grabbed command after a brief skirmish at the five-sixteenths pole, still held it with an eighth to go, but with the runner up in hot pursuit, reached the sixteenth pole with only the narrowest of edges, then dug in stubbornly the rest of the way under good handling to fend off MIAMI HAMMER and preserve the decision. MIAMI HAMMER was bumped lightly by the top one at the start, settled along the inside before reaching the opening bend, patiently tracked the front runner under a firm hold, found room to ease into the two path in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, moved up willingly under mild hand urging, paused when briefly boxed in amongst rivals coming to the quarter pole, found sufficient racing clearance to resume his bid a couple of jumps into the stretch drive, closed the gap, loomed boldly with a sixteenth remaining, but wasn't able to go by a determined foe. LINDSEY'S BUCK taken off the rail leaving the first turn, went on to rally mildly en route for the show. WINNING TOKEN took the inside route, was set down at the quarter pole but came up empty. PAYOUT reserved, moved up into contention departing the backstretch, sat well placed three wide at the three-eighths pole, but soon flattened out. STONES THROW rated inside, gave way after completing three-quarters. HASTEN TO BE KING underwent a three to four wide journey and folded.
