LOCAL LEGACY ranged up three wide on the turn, took off in earnest when set down in upper stretch, gained command just past the eighth pole and edged clear, driving. TACONIC KNIGHT contently prompted the leader from the outside for nearly a half, went on to challenge for command during the run through the furlong grounds, and finished willingly to procure the place. GOODNIGHT BRAD urged to assume control, showed the way towards the inside, was put to the test in upper stretch, offered resistance until the furlong marker and steadily weakened thereafter. ALLEN'S AFFAIR underwent a three wide pursuit and displayed a mild kick, improving position by mainly weak and tired ones. DOUBLE ROAR cut the corner into the stretch and lacked the needed response. TRINITY WARRIOR kept pace from the outside for a half before folding. MARKET ANALYSIS displayed brief foot. FRANTIC DOMER steadily lost ground on the field after having the saddle slip down the backstretch, was in the process of being eased into the stretch, when the rider fell off coming to the three-sixteenths pole.
