Footnotes

SAN PABLO disputed the pace from the outside, rating kindly while doing so, pulled away from C V EIS midpoint down the backstretch, was let out a notch upon reaching the far turn, got put to the test by the runner up at the five-sixteenths pole, raced with that opponent still latched on the outside for a short distance longer before being let out, shook free making his way from upper to midstretch, extended the margin in the final furlong, crossing the wire, hand urged. ISN'T HE PERFECT was on the receiving end of several choppy strokes on the right shoulder leaving the starting gate, raced three wide around both turns, picked up the pace midway down the backstretch, was asked for a response and moved up to confront the winner after completing three-quarters, turned for home still hooked on to that one's hind quarters, fell back steadily when unable to sustain the challenge, dug in well to preserve the place. SAM SPARKLE took the inside route around the opening bend, was taken outward entering the backstretch and remained off the inside thereafter, got called upon in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole and was out finished. C V EIS vied for the lead from the inside during the initial stages, then faded.
