AGAVE KISS put to some light encouragement springing away from the starting gate, was switched over to a snug hold on the reins by the rider after establishing control, set the splits on an open lead, entered the stretch with a comfortable advantage, got set down to a hand drive, was still in command with an eighth to go and remained so under urging to the end. WELL KEPT chased the loose leader from off the inside, proved no match. CORDEROSA sat reserved, placed just off the rail, was angled out sharply from the five-sixteenths pole in preparation for the stretch drive, settling into the four path by upper stretch, got out finished by the top pair. DANCE TO BRISTOL bobbled at the break, stalked the leader from afar, coaxed along, tired steadily after completing a half. BETTER LUCKY off the inside, was no menace. CUTE CADET was taken hold just after the start, as the winner was working her way to the rail, saved ground throughout and was outrun. PERENNIAL SONG raced along the outside and was through after going a half.
