SAN NAA sprinted clear on the rail, dug in when challenged in midstretch and prevailed after a long drive. TURAATH pressed the pace from outside, lodged a bid in midstretch and hung late. GOOD KARMA saved ground just behind the leaders to the top of the stretch and lacked a late response. JED GREELEY raced in close contention three wide to the turn and lacked a late response. LONGING FOR MALIBU raced between horses in midstretch and faded in the stretch. WANTED ALIVE raced wide throughout while being outrun. DRIVEN BY ROYAL trailed.
