Footnotes

PETE'S PARLEY vied for the lead from the two path, responded well when given his cue in upper stretch and dug in stubbornly to turn back PRIX DE KARAKORUM and preserve the decision. PRIX DE KARAKORUM contested the pace three wide throughout, but had to settle for being second best. FORTITUDE was bumped at the start, moved into a forward position, was steadied in tight quarters amongst rivals in the vicinity of the seven-sixteenths turn, proved no match for the two twosome. FIRST DAY well placed tracking the front runners from the inside, came up empty for the stretch drive. RIZZI'S COMET bumped after the start, made a bid after entering the lane but soon flattened out. CAP THE MOMENT saved ground and failed to menace. READING GROUP exchanged a series of bumps right at and just after the start, was through after going a half. FUGEDABOUTIT SANDY never reached contention. SOURCEOFTHENILE bounced around at the beginning of the contest, raced four wide and gave way.
