**Footnotes**

MINESWEPT sat in the pocket keeping a watchful eye on the pacesetter, was eased outward and beat BOUND BY HUMOR to position at the five-sixteenths pole, approached the head of the stretch and was set down, closed a minimal amount of ground during the initial portion of the stretch drive, gained more readily from the eighth pole onward, struck the front with about a sixteenth to go and edged away, driving. WISE STOP was sent over to the rail departing the backstretch, showed the way on a loosely-contested lead, was let out just as the top one was commencing to rally in earnest, got collared in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, but easily held off the others for the place. COALTOWN LEGEND three wide and between opponents for a good portion of the run around the bend, rallied well to secure the show, although never posing a threat to the first two finishers. NEVER RIGHT JOEY raced three wide, remained a prominent factor until midstretch before backing away. BOUND BY HUMOR chased from off the inside and gave way shortly after going a half. TOO TOUGH JAKE made solid contact with BUD WHITE at the start, raced along the outside and failed to reach a contending position. BUD WHITE bumped at the break, was never involved. ESTIMATOR saved ground and faded. YOU DO was the first to pop out of the starting gate, despite breaking to the outside, departed the backstretch from the four path, had little left after completing the opening half.
