Footnotes

HE'S A SCROOGE bumped with SOLUTIONFINDERS leaving the starting gate, went on to take control soon afterwards and tucked along the inside, set the splits, facing only the mildest of resistance, shook well clear of the competition late on the turn, still not being asked for much run, was set down to a vigorous hand ride from the three-sixteenths to wire to remain well clear. CELLA MUFFLER gave chase for off the inside for most of the way around the bend, was taken inward and cut the corner into the lane, finished well enough to be along for the place. GREAT RECESSION rode the rail until the quarter pole, got out finished. SOLUTIONFINDERS was steadied after being sandwiched between opponents at the break, took up position from off the inside in midpack, had no rally. OLD KIT BAG raced along the outside and through after completing a half. LIME ZEST three to four wide around the turn, was no threat. BLACK MARKET MONEY was used leaving the starting gate to make it into midpack, entered the turn from the three path and left it from the five path, had no stretch response. NUMEROUS ONE got bumped at the start, was guided into the three path coming to the half mile pole, was never in contention. CALL THE GENERAL three wide, displayed brief foot. OUT OF YOUR MIND stalked the top one from the two path and gave way.
