SALIC LAW quickly showed in front, set the pace along the inside while in hand, responded when roused, dug in gamely and was driving under the line. OCEANO raced close up early while between rivals, came wide into the stretch and finished gamely outside. ONE NICE CAT was rated along inside, saved ground and finished gamely on the rail. MONOCULAR raced close up early while in hand, rallied four wide approaching the stretch and finished well outside. MITHAAL was outrun early along the inside, came wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. DR. ROCKETT had no response when roused. LE PARRAIN (ARG) raced in hand early, put in a three wide run on the second turn and tired in the final furlong. WILD MAPLE raced wide and had no rally. ALOCADITO (ARG) pressed the pace from the outside and tired.
