UNDERSTATEMENT sprinted clear soon after the start, raced in hand while racing uncontested on the lead to the turn, shook loose in upper stretch and drew away under a vigorous hand ride. WELL POSITIONED tucked in along the rail, saved ground just off the pace for five furlongs, saved ground to the turn, took up chase after his entymate but was no match for that one while clearly best of the others. STORM PLAY raced in midpack from outside for a half, lodged a mild three wide move on the turn and lacked a strong closing response. AH DAY raced in hand along the rail on the backstretch and failed to mount a serious rally. MORE THAN A REASON raced three wide while well back for five furlongs and lacked the needed response when called upon. BUNKER HILL prompted the winner in the two path and gave way in upper stretch.
