MARLENE'S PEARL out broke the field, vied for the lead with the runner up directly alongside, had already drifted out into the two path arriving on the far turn, continued to venture outward thereafter, was put to a hard drive and held sway. UNRULY STORM made a three wide run to join the winner up front, raced as a team with that one down the backstretch and for a good portion of the run around the bend, fell back steadily from the five-sixteenths pole, managed to hold on to the place. SKY FEVER off the inside, was devoid of early speed, fanned gradually to be six wide at the head of the stretch and was along in time for the show. DECORATED COURT saved ground to no avail. G. A. EMPRESS unhurried for the opening six furlongs while taking the inside route, angled off the rail in midstretch, came up empty. READY TO PARTY contently stalked the front runners from the outside, ducked over to the rail in the vicinity of the seven-sixteenths pole, taking over the inside recently vacated by the top one, got roused by upper stretch, failed to fire. MINISTER'S FATE strung out in the three path around both turns, spun into the lane under a right handed whip, folded. DOROTHY'S ESSENCE fell to face at the start, losing the rider as a result. There was a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the start of the race before the result was declared official.
