Footnotes

CHAPMAN raced along the outside, chased the pacesetter while being urged along on the turn, swung three wide into upper stretch, began to pick up real estate in the final furlong, got up near the wire to prove best. IN HARM'S WAY went head to head with COMANDANTE for much of the way down the backstretch, was conceded the front as the pair was approaching the half mile pole, tucked along the rail a short distance past that station, set the second split, being rated and facing only token resistance, felt the pressure beginning to increase turning for home and got called upon in response, lost none of his advantage during the run through the furlong grounds, saw it dwindle down steadily thereafter, got collared by CHAPMAN prior to the wire, but reached it in time to salvage second. COMANDANTE sparred with the runner up during the initial stages, doing so while saving ground, was put to a solid hold and allowed to ease back late down the backstretch, tracked the leader while continuing to take the inside route on the turn, got taken outward heading for the top of the lane, closed in well late en route for the show. WILD FINISH rode the rail on the turn, and had a good finish along the inside in the stretch. LEILANI'S TICKET well off the inside throughout, was under a drive taking the four path for entrance into the stretch, lacked the needed response. GOODTLOOK ducked out awkwardly at the start and wound up bobbling, was never in contention.
