FOXBEAU needed some brisk hand urging in the early going to secure a forward position, crept up steadily departing the half mile pole, challenged as the widest of three spinning into the lane, with the runner up a short distance behind, and took over, kicked clear, then extended the advantage while drifting out several paths in the last eighth. MARGARET OWNZIT well off the inside throughout, got tipped into the four path approaching the five-sixteenths marker, proved no match. KISS CAT was quickly sent over to the rail, raced for a good portion of the way around the turn under a drive, cut the corner into the lane, held on well enough to take the show. FRONT COVER DREAM grabbed hold after breaking a few steps to the outside, raced mostly two wide on the turn, got fanned into the five path coming into the stretch, made no impact. STRONG ENOUGH prompted the winner towards the two path, was between rivals as the half was being completed, backed away. POSSETIVEVIBRATION along the inside, yielded without putting up much resistance when challenged by a pair of rivals parked to the outside a short distance from the quarter pole.
