MOONLIGHT SONG a bit fractious broke through the gate prior to the start, broke in at the start squeezing UNCLE T SEVEN out in tandem with pressure from the inside caused by NIGHT MANEUVER breaking outwards, attended the pace two to three wide, took over command narrowly at the head of the stretch and was roused into the lane, inched away under a drive kept to task to the wire. PALACE bumped lightly at the start, was well rated just off the pace just off the inside, got set down at the head of the stretch, offered up a mild kick making steady progress late on and just got up for the place honors on the line. NIGHT MANEUVER broke out at the start bumping PALACE lightly into BUG JUICE which caused pressure that in tandem with MOONLIGHT SONG breaking inwards squeezed back UNCLE T SEVEN, set the pace inside in hand attended from the outside, came under encouragement under threat nearing the quarter pole, cut the corner displaced on the front into upper stretch, kept on well to the wire but was nailed in the last jump for the place honors while clear of the rest. DAN'S GOLD bumped at the start lightly in a chain reaction due to pressure inside, was forwardly place three wide in aim of the front, came under a ride three furlongs out, swung four wide for home and offered no serious response. UNCLE T SEVEN squeezed back between foes at the start due to pressure from both sides, settled two to three wide towards the rear, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths and offered no response. BUG JUICE bumped lightly at the start, saved ground throughout while trailing.
