THE MAGIC STONE contently tracked the front runners, kept at a distance from off the inside, slipped into the two path in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, split rivals entering the lane, altered course outward after a few strides into the stretch drive, drew even with TALENT N PASSION with about a sixteenth remaining, went by and edged away, crossing the wire under a less than vigorous hand ride. E Z PASSER took an awkward first step outward, brought up the back of the pack, reserved from off the rail for the opening half, got fanned six wide, the widest of all, into the stretch, displayed good belated energy to take the place. TALENT N PASSION initially hand urged to clear the field, was switched over to rating tactics once comfortably in front and sent over to the inside, got challenged by a frantically-handled CUBICLE QUEEN as the half was being completed, was almost a sixteenth down the road before getting asked for her best, got collared by the winner a furlong later and eventually weakened into the show slot. DARLING BRIDEZILLA asked for more and more on the turn while undergoing a ground-saving journey, came up empty. LITTLE ROCKET in the two path departing the backstretch, commenced to get angled out four wide from the five-sixteenths pole, lacked the necessary stretch response. CUBICLE QUEEN stalked the pacesetter from the the outside, bid weakly under a full drive approaching the quarter pole and gave way.
