**Footnotes**

MISSILE MOTOR dueled between horses early, battled heads apart along the rail on the turn, shook loose in upper stretch and was fully extended to hold off the runner-up in the late stages. CHIEF EXPORT was reserved early, closed the gap from outside on the turn, circled four wide into the stretch and was steadily gaining on the winner at the finish. FLEET VALID steadied briefly on the first turn, settled in good position just off the early pace, awaited room while gaining inside on the turn then rallied mildly along the rail to hold for a share. THE VIN MAN raced between horses early, steadied in traffic while lacking room midway on the turn then rallied belatedly when clear. BILL PLACE checked in tight at the start, raced far back while five wide for a half then rallied mildly from outside. JAPENGO saved ground while outrun for a half, angled out in upper stretch and failed to threaten. CITY ATTRACTION dueled three wide outside the winner for a half and gave way. BIG BRIAN T steadied along the rail and was shuffled back on the far turn, checked inside on the turn and gave way. CLERY'S CONTENDER was outrun along the inside.
