TAP ATTACK sat within range throughout while undergoing a three wide journey, advanced under encouragement nearing the five-sixteenth pole to challenge for command, drove to the lead by upper stretch and edged away while being kept to the task at hand. GREELEY'S LAW unhurried off the inside during the initial half, left the backstretch three wide, slowly ranged up being urged right along, then continued on willingly down the stretch to take the place. ONE WAY TO ROCK fought noticeably against the bit while making his way to the front, showed the way towards the inside under pressure, remained a forward factor until midstretch and gave way. WITH A CAPE pressed the pace from the outside for three-quarters and tired. NUB THROWER off a beat slowly, was set down to a drive coming to the seven-sixteenths pole, made up some ground during the run around the second bend, but could not sustain the move after entering the stretch. RAFFIE'S CHOICE bobbed at the break, sat within range during the opening half, was put to encouragement on the far turn and backed off. TYCOON CAT saved ground and faded.
