FORT HUGHES urged from the starting gate to assume the lead, drifted outward in steady fashion down the backstretch, was allowed to settle back into proper stride, having been placed in the two path coming to the seven-sixteenths pole, showed the way from there on a loosely-contested lead, responded positively when put to a vigorous hand ride after entering the stretch and drew clear. ROYAL CURRIER away well was carried out by the top one as that pair proceeded down the backstretch, worked his way back towards the rail gradually, took up pursuit three wide around the turn, failed to keep pace with the winner after turning for home but continued on willingly to be second best. RIFT chased the front runners from the two path and proved no match. BRAVO ROMEO tentatively handled leaving the gate, keeping a wary eye on the early antics of the top one, left the backstretch from the three path, lacked the necessary stretch after turning for home. RUNNING TAP saved ground to no avail. BAMBİ BOUND five wide at the top of lane, had no kick.
