### Footnotes

POPPY DAY broke running and assumed a good forward position, was rated while patiently stalking the pacesetter three wide, continued along on the same scenario for nearly three-quarters, was forced into the four path by the runner up turning for home as the pair engaged in a spirited tussle for the lead, steadily drifting inward after settling into the stretch, even as she struck the front by midstretch, clung to a narrow edge during the last eighth, while bumping with MY HONEY LAURIE nearing the finish line. MY HONEY LAURIE held off several other rivals to take control after the start, was rated near the two path, being mildly pressed by the top one, swung three wide into the lane with the top one now in hot pursuit, fought for the lead, gradually inching her way towards the inside, in response to mild pressure coming from POPPY DAY all the while, continued onward with good courage after reluctantly yielding midstretch, bumping with the aforementioned foe as they approached the wire. LINDSAY'S POINT raced off the inside, was set down in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole and got outkicked. DOWNTOWN HOTTIE between rivals on the far turn, lacked the needed response. LAGNIAPPE loped along during the initial stages, swung into the two path entering the backstretch, attempted to reach contention with a four wide run on the second bend, but flattened out. KATY'S OFFICE GIRL angled off the inside leaving the five-sixteenths pole. SKY FEVER came wide off the second turn, settled into the five path for the start of the stretch drive but had no serious offering to give. PAY THE FARE tracked the front runners from the inside for six furlongs and faltered. HEAR HER ROAR always near the back of the pack, drifted six wide into the stretch and tired.
