Footnotes

INVOCATION tracked the front runners from the pocket, under a snug hold from the pilot in the initial stages, vacated the inside route coming to the five-sixteenths pole, turned for home two wide under encouragement, tipped a bit wider after going a few additional strides for better racing clearance, began to pick up speed shortly before reaching the sixteenth pole, went by the fighting front runners in last seventy yards and edged away, crossing the wire under a strong hand drive. VOLITION assumed a forward position soon after the start, applied sufficient pressure on the leader from the outside during the opening stages, advanced with interest upon entering the far turn to latch on to LAKE SUPERIOR, dueled on nearly terms for the remainder of the way to the quarter pole, had the battle spill over into the stretch, forged his way to a slim advantage in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, failed to stave off the top one's challenge soon afterwards, but dug in gamely to preserve the place, then was vanned off after the finish. LAKE SUPERIOR broke alertly to quickly grab the advantage, was put to a firm hold by the rider making his way down the homestretch, argued to maintain control with the runner up, at first from just of the rail, and then mostly near the two path around the second bend, fell back by a head with about a sixteenth to go, continued onward with vigor but had to settle for the show. BUDDYS AFLEET along the inside and under a firm hold by the rider, became a bit rank shortly before arriving on the first turn, exchanged a series of light bumps, totaling three altogether, with RAFFIE'S STAR during the opening half of the run around the first turn, became a bit more professionally soon after entering the backstretch, continued along the inside and made no impact. CAT MAN FU saved ground until the quarter pole, was already under solid encouragement entering the stretch, came up empty. RAFFIE'S STAR raced along the outside, traded several light bumps with a slightly erratic BUDDYS AFLEET early on the opening bend, was asked for run on the subsequent one to keep pace with the front runners, folded.
