**Footnotes**

GIANT FINISH vied to maintain control while saving ground, with the runner up in close attendance parked one path further to the outside, edged away from the opponent as he was completing six furlongs, remained well clear under good handling. SINISTRA made a three wide run to become the primary pursuer, kept pace for almost six furlongs, got shaken off shortly before entering the lane, came home well enough to preserve the place. JAMES JINGLE three wide entering the backstretch, was near the rail by the quarter pole, lacked the needed late energy to reel in the top one. THE BROTHERS RAP off a beat slowly, was quickly guided over to the inside, took the inside route down the backstretch, was steadied when bumped lightly by another caught in tight at the half mile pole, lost some ground and momentum as a result of the incident, got going soon afterwards and picked up the pace prior to spinning into the stretch, only to flatten out by upper stretch. NOOSH'S TALE raced along the outside, was bumped lightly by ALCOLITE in the vicinity of the half mile pole, gottet out a notch and angled outward late on the second turn, lacked the needed response. DOUBLE CLAP three wide on the first turn, remained off the inside, tired after turning for home. ALCOLITE was showing some resistance against the bit before arriving at the first turn, appeared unsettled under a snug hold by the rider, eased her way towards the outside more than halfway down the backstretch, bumped when in caught in between rivals at the half mile pole, dropped back slightly with the slight loss of momentum and was through by the end of the far turn.
