SING DIXIE SING shot to the front with a very alert getaway, dashed over to the inside and made it there well before reaching the end of the backstretch, cut the pace, being rated an open lead, entered the stretch and was switched over to the drive, had the advantage cut into slice by slice by the runner up, but held sway, kept to the task at hand. CINEMATIZE was guided over to the rail shortly after the start, remained at near the inside route for the rest of the way to the quarter pole, got taken hold after appearing a bit keen halfway through the run around the bend, went onward for a few additional strides before slipping past a pair of rivals along a narrow passageway in the area of the five-sixteenths pole, angled outward turning for home as she got set down, gained steadily on the winner en route for the place. PEGGY JANE chased the top one from afar from along the two path, was let out a notch a short distance past the half mile pole, but with no noticeable pick up in speed, wound up in tight between rivals coming to the quarter pole, eventually getting squeezed back, had the rider steady while making some contact with POSITIVE PITCH, who was racing in close proximity to her outside at that stage, regained some interest before completing the trip through the furlong grounds to earn the show award. SALTAMONTES given some motivation with a series of choppy strokes on the right shoulder just after the start, had the rider steady briefly as the second place finisher was settling along the inside shortly afterwards, proceeded two jumps before being allowed to drift out to be three wide, remained out there racing around the turn, was asked for run and spun slightly wider into the stretch, made no headway on the front runners. POSITIVE PITCH underwent a three wide pursuit, bumped with PEGGY JANE approaching the quarter pole, backed away. SHE'S GOT RULES closely-positioned behind the incident at the bottom of the turn, steadied while angling outward turning for home, had no rally.
