Footnotes

WILDHAASSEE hustled from the start, established the front and set the pace from just off the inside in reserve until the five-sixteenths, came under urging at that station, drew clear to the eighth pole, saw that margin cut into late on while kept to task to the wire. MAJESTIC PLAYER hustled from the start, raced three to four wide off the pace, came under a long drive from the seven-sixteenths, gave chase through the turn, rallied in the stretch gaining in the late stages while well clear of the rest and second best. BRANDY'S BIG GUY bumped lightly at the start, settled three wide in mid pack, came under a ride three furlongs out, spun four wide for home and weakened in the final furlong. RUMACK hard to load prior to the start, settled four to five wide in mid pack, came under a long drive from the seven-sixteenths, swung three wide for home and weakened in the drive. RIVER RON chased the front three wide in closest pursuit, got called upon midway on the turn and weakened. THUNDERVILLE off a beat slow, saved ground towards the rear, came under encouragement three furlongs out and offered no response. MR. MASTERPIECE cornered poorly into the first turn and got out steadily to be six or seven paths off the rail into the backside despite the rider's efforts, settled well off the inside towards the rear, continued in the overland route through the far turn and was never a factor. PROUD STAN broke in at the start bumping BRANDY'S BIG GUY lightly, settled inside towards the rear, got detached from the main body of the group midway and was eased at the head of the lane.
