### Footnotes

PAX IN TERRA raced four wide around both turns, was the widest of the front runners entering the stretch on nearly even terms, got set down shortly afterwards and edged away, driving. WOKE UP TIRED vacated the inside route coming to the end of the backstretch, got angled out five wide starting from the five-sixteenths pole, finished well enough to get the place. TOOHOTTOEVENSPEAK raced from off the inside throughout, pressed the pace from the three path around the far turn, turned for home from between rivals, but with some space between him and the winner, got out finished. HARBOR KING inside early, went on to best the rest. POLICE CAMP lunged at the break, entered the far turn three wide and departed it six wide, had no offering. MINERAL WATER along the inside and under encouragement down the backstretch, failed to make his presence felt, swung outward after going three-quarters, made no impact. RIDE OF YOUR LIFE two wide for most of the way to the quarter pole, spun slightly wider into the stretch, tired. LATIGO TRAIL near the inside, gave up the lead shortly before going six furlongs. GINO AND THE JETS strung out three wide on the opening bend, contended for the lead down the backstretch and gave way. THUNDERIN SARATOGA saved ground and offered little.
