FLY WITH KARAKORUM chased the pace from the outside and held the place despite drifting out badly in the stretch. QUEEN OF SARATOGA chased the pace while three wide and lacked a rally. PUMA'S PRIDE had no response when roused. TAP MACHINE stumbled at the start, dropped back early, raced wide and had no rally. HUSSY chased the pace while between rivals and tired. GONE MUSICAL tired badly and was eased in the stretch.
