### Footnotes

INGER MANAGEMENT sprinted clear along the rail, dug in when threaten in upper stretch and held off the runner-up under steady right hand urging. KATSKILL BAY pressed the winner in the two path, lodged a bid at the quarter pole but couldn't get by that one while holding well for the place. DRIVEN BY SOLAR angled in along the backstretch, steadied behind the leaders on the far turn, raced just off the pace into upper stretch and finished willingly. STRONG IMPACT chased the leaders three wide to the turn and lacked a late response. MONTE CARLO checked at the start, swerved to the outside in the early stages, raced well back while four wide for a half and failed to mount a serious rally thereafter. MONASTIR was outrun after breaking slowly, altered course to the outside leaving the turn and lacked a rally. THE KNIGHTLY NEWS rushed up inside, steadied along the rail leaving the five-eighths pole, dropped back on the turn and lacked a further response. BROOKS HALL was never a factor while saving ground.
