### Footnotes

TAQARUB stumbled at the start, sprinted clear early, opened a wide gap in upper stretch and drew away under a vigorous hand ride. THE PRINCE settled just off the early pace, lodged a mild three wide move on the turn but was no match for the winner. FELLOW CRASHER checked leaving the gate, steadied while lacking room at the three-eighths pole and failed to threaten thereafter. GREAT DEBATER steadied and was pinched back at the start then saved ground to no avail. GIANT RYAN pressed the winner from outside and gave way on the turn. NAOS was shuffled back a bit leaving the far turn and was never close thereafter.
