Footnotes

PAY IN KIND raced in midpack, advanced between horses three wide at the quarter pole, gained steadily in midstretch and drew clear in the final seventy yards then stumbled pulling up unseating the rider in the process. THE TRUFFLE MAN pressed the pace from outside for a half, opened a clear lead in midstretch but couldn't hold the winner safe. METHODTOMYMADNESS set the pace along the rail for nearly five furlongs and weakened. OUR ROYAL AFFAIR raced up close along the rail, raced in traffic leaving the far turn, lodged a bid along the rail entering the stretch and flattened out. COACH BUTTS chased four wide for a half and tired. WOLFSON steadied between horses along the backstretch, circled five wide at the quarter pole and lacked a late response. PERSONAL GOOD checked in tight leaving the gate, steadied in traffic on the far turn and failed to threaten thereafter. HALF A NOTE steadied along the rail at the three-eighths pole, saved ground for a half and tired. MERLIN CIRCLE raced four wide to the turn, drifted out and was in hand late.
