HOOKED ON DANCE got bumped from both sides at the break, shook it off and was cross-reined to clear the field and establish control, was rated from the rail on a loosely-contested lead, turned for home with a comfortable advantage, fended off the sole stretch threat under strong handling. TERMINUS contently tracked the pacesetter from the pocket, slipped to the outside in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, commenced to rally in earnest entering the lane, had to settle for being second best. GOODTIME BOY chased from the outside, launched a mild rally to secure the show. THOMAS HILL brushed with JOHNNY JADE, broke near the top nevertheless but fell back despite some urging from the rider, remained under active encouragement undergoing a four wide pursuit around the bend, closed the gap slightly nearing the quarter pole but soon flattened out. TAP CHAP got squeezed back to last at the break after making contact with rivals from both the right and the left, failed to reach a contending position. JOHNNY JADE made light contact with THOMAS HILL at the start, was taken inward by that rival for a stride, had the rider pull off in time before making more significant contact with several others, gave chase down the backstretch and around the turn and backed away. COYOTE CANYON got bumped at the start, raced three wide, was heartily urged into the lane, came up empty. HOWIE AND THE CAT bumped at the start, chased from off the inside, was under a drive entering the stretch, folded.
