Footnotes

THE MAD PIPER spotted an incoming INQUEST, and gently eased enough towards the inside to avoid making any contact with that rival, went on to secure the front, took up residence in the two path and cut the pace, with the rider using ratings tactics all the while, began to edge away from the field approaching the quarter pole, arrived at that station and got asked for a response, gave it willingly, drawing off to win by a large margin, crossing the wire under a brisk hand ride. CAMERON CANYON three wide, gave futile chase on the winner, held on well enough for the place. MY COUSIN EDDIE three wide at the three-eighths pole, lacked the necessary stretch response. HIDDEN VOW sat loosely-pocket, put to some light urging, was fully roused by the five-sixteenths marker, tired. STORMING PAST was taken hold just after the start, raced widest off all throughout and folded. HUNT CLUB SPECIAL ran as the trailer for the initial half, came about four wide into upper stretch, raced erratically, moving back and forth through the furlong grounds. INQUEST came inward sharply at the break, and got checked by the rider before resuming a truer course, was through after going a half.
