Footnotes

N. F.'S DESTINY quickly cleared the field after the start to take control, was guided over to the inside, cut the pace, facing no pressure at all throughout the opening half and with the rider showing only the slightest of hand movement on the reins to maintain interest, drew off from the others late on the turn en route to emerge with his biggest advantage in upper stretch, had it chopped down deceptively by the the next finishers, particularly in the final sixteenth, reached the wire with time to spare, never having been asked for run while proceeding down the stretch. VERBOSITY bumped with CYBERTRON at the start, took up position along the outside, started to pick up the pace coming to the quarter pole, rallied in tandem with MINESWEPT leaving the eighth pole, gained substantial ground on the unasked top one in the late stages, showed good determination to win the battle for the place. MINESWEPT raced towards the inside, under some encouragement on the turn, got outfinished by the runner up and had to settle for the show. CAP THE MOMENT was in the three path and under a drive prior to the five-sixteenths pole, fanned five wide into the stretch while travelling just off an errant CYBERTRON at that juncture, had no rally. CYBERTRON broke towards the inside in an awkward manner initiating contact with the nearest opponent as a result, stalked the winner from the two path without ever making his presence felt, rider atop with a snug grip on the left reins, received some attention with the stick on the right shoulder shortly before arriving at the quarter pole, had the rider relax his previously-described hold coming into the stretch and went to to swing four wide into the stretch, then backed away.
