Footnotes

JET SET CAT came away well from the starting gate, kicked away from the rest to take control early, was rated along on a loosely-contested lead in the opening stages, had GREELEY'S LAW draw directly alongside shortly after entering the backstretch, vied with that opponent heads apart until coming to the five-sixteenths pole, rider still not asking the mount for any pick up in speed, flicked off the nemesis just as CREA'S LAW was starting to pick up interest, turned for home and got set down, dug in under a drive to preserve the decision. JUNIOR OFFICER off the inside, was between rivals for a good portion of the way around the far turn, took the three path for entrance into the stretch, doing so under a drive, got straightened away and came home with good energy to secure second. CREA'S LAW took the inside route, fell back slightly leaving the half mile pole and was put to some hand urging in response, cut the corner under much stronger handling, stayed within range of the winner throughout the stretch drive, but lacked the necessary late response. GREELEY'S LAW got hung out four wide on the opening bend, rider atop with a firm grip on the reins, had the rider relax the hold a bit and keenly moved up to engage the top one, raced as a team with that opponent, momentarily poking a head in front during the dispute, got shaken off late on the far turn, held on reasonably well to the end to earn the last major check. TOWERING MOON got off a length behind the next to last breaker, who himself was a length behind the one in front at the start, dashed over to the rail and rode it on the first turn, tipped into the two path midway down the backstretch and remained off the inside thereafter, was asked to pick it up by the half mile pole, failed to do so noticeably, entered the stretch under a full drive and made no headway on the front runners. ALI'S WINNER three wide on the far turn, tired. TONINTHIRTEEN in the three path until the half mile pole, gave way.
