MOMENTS NOTIZ tracked the front runners while taking the inside route, lacked clear sailing from upper to midstretch, had the obstacle maneuver to the outside with an eighth to go, availed of the newly-created rail passageway and got put to a response, zipped by to take over a sixteenth down the road, edged away, kept to a brisk hand ride. DOUBLEDOWN AGAIN chased the pacesetter from near the rail, vacated the premises by altering course to be outside HEAD HEART HOOF in the vicinity of the eighth pole, leaving the rail route for the asking to the winner, rallied to take the place. HEAD HEART HOOF broke on top and settled into the two path, vied with LOVE TO THE MAX, himself down along the rail, and successfully maintained a slim advantage during the initial stages, shook free upon reaching the turn, got set down for the drive home, felt heavy pressure with a furlong to go, held on well for another sixteenth before relinquishing. QUICK MONEY brushed after the break, raced along the outside and lacked the needed response. SHANKOPOTAMUS bumped after the start, underwent a three wide pursuit, backed away after entering the stretch. LOVE TO THE MAX sparred with HEAD HEART HOOF while saving ground down the backstretch, got whisked off after leaving the half mile pole, was angled outward past the five-sixteenths pole, commenced the stretch three wide, gave way. PLEASEANDTHANKYOU stumbled badly after being bumped very shortly after the start, raced primarily two wide on the turn, tipped into the three path at the top of the lane, trailed throughout.
