ERIK THE RED just off the pace just off the inside initially, shifted to the three path three furlongs out, commenced a bid from the five-sixteenths into contention coming to the quarter pole, rallied to challenge for command a furlong out, took over narrowly nearing the sixteenth marker, dug in under threat by a pair late and just held on. START JUMPING three to four wide in pursuit, got set down at the head of the lane, rallied with late energy in tandem with GOMBHEY DANCER along his inside and just missed. GOMBHEY DANCER coaxed just off the pace just off the inside, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, angled to the three path nearing the eighth pole, rallied with late energy along the inside of START JUMPING and just missed. MAKE YOUR MOVE allowed to settle at the rear just off the inside, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, angled out to the three path at the three-sixteenths, offered up a mild rally but was out kicked by the top trio. MULHEB on the pace in hand just off the inside, cut the corner into the stretch let out for the drive under challenge, dug in fighting on clinging to the front a furlong from home, got headed nearing the sixteenth marker and was outfinished in the late stages while keeping on mildly to the end. MUCH STRONGER away awkwardly at the start, tracked the pace inside in range, was steadied briefly in a bit tight nearing the quarter pole, cut the corner into the stretch, dug in mildly to the eighth pole when appearing to be trying to lug in and tired.
