FLARING sat reserved from off the inside in the middle of the pack, was asked for a response and picked up both speed and interest getting angled outward coming to the five-sixteenth pole, challenged as the widest of three front runners on nearly even terms with each other for command entering the stretch, vied as the widest of three for the lead for most of the final eighth and after continuing onward with good determination got the head down in time at the wire to prevail. TIZAROCKET broke alertly and maintained a forward position throughout, pressed the issue from the two path, had the winner join in on the pace fight coming to the quarter pole, got set down for the drive home, fought with vigor from between rivals in the final furlong, but lost the bob. COLONEL JUANITA was guided over to the rail, rode it while being rated until approaching the quarter pole, was put to encouragement and cut the corner into the stretch, gained ground readily, tipped slightly towards the outside, squeezing her way into the two path, split rivals near the eighth pole and got hooked up a three-way tussle with the first two finishers the rest of the way home, displayed determination but had to settle for the show. D' KENNESAW CAT off the inside, tipped into the four path at the five-sixteenths pole, swung from the same path into the stretch, lacked the needed response. WARNING TRACKPOWER swung four wide into the stretch, made no impact. NIGHT TIME SLIPPER put to hand urging after the start, cleared the field by enough to tuck along the rail in time for the start of the run around the bend, got put to the test by another pair parked to her outside approaching the quarter pole, succumbed in short order and backed away. PRINCESA DE PAPI under solid urging cutting the corner into the stretch, had no offering.
