### Footnotes

COPPER FOREST chased the pace under a hold while three wide, took over the front under his own power from a tiring foe at the five-sixteenths, was roused turning for home and edged clear driving through the final furlong. CONSTABULARY reserved off the pace, began to come under light coaxing at the three-eighths, advanced through the turn, swung four wide at the head of the lane, rallied steadily through the stretch unable to gain appreciably on the winner while safe for the place spot. GIOPI (IRE) chased the pace while three wide, improved position through the turn, came under rousing while swinging three wide at the quarter pole, bid mildly through the stretch for the show honors while not able to keep pace with the top two in the late stages. WILDLEE SPECIAL tracked the pace from midpack while saving ground until the quarter pole, angled out to the four path at that station while under a drive, bid mildly through the lane for the last major share. GAMBLIN FEVER allowed to settle early on at the back, angled out four wide at the head of the stretch, rallied by tired foes through the furlong grounds. THE VIN MAN tracked the pace from the two path, came under encouragement at the quarter pole and faltered. FRENCH TRANSITION off a beat slow, came under urging midway on the turn while taking the overland route and offered no response. LIBERTY ST. OUTLAW broke well, rushed to the front under a hold three wide around the first turn, saved ground while setting the pace until the five-sixteenths and gave way.
