BELAMY got engaged in a duel with TOUGH ALL DAY nearly from the get-go, fought with intensity with that opponent while placed along the rail, with FREUDIANTHERAPIST having the best view, albeit at a considerable distance behind, for the opening half, was put to urgent urging by the five-sixteenths pole, bumped with his nemesis turning for home as the somewhat leg weary pair of front runners leaned upon at this juncture, edged away while drifting out in the final furlong. AMBASSADOR BRIDGE rode the rail for almost a half, was angled four wide into the stretch, came home well enough to outfinish the vanquished dueler for the place. TOUGH ALL DAY got hooked up in pace dispute very soon after the start, fought on even terms with that rival from the outside, made contact with the winner entering the stretch, the result of the taxing effects of the battle starting to show, got shaken off, steadily tired then lasted for the show. STONEMILL lacked a solid closing response while missing out third. JACKIN MY STYLE three wide at the three-eighths pole, was outrun. FREUDIAN THERAPIST raced along the outside, was coaxed along but failed to keep pace with the embattled pair up front, gave way. TYCOON CAT dwelt at the star and was never in contention.
