UNBRIDLED LOGIC tracked the front just off the inside mid pack, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, progressed into prominence swinging three wide at the quarter pole, seized the lead straightening for home, inched off under a drive to the eighth pole, drifted out slightly through the final eighth digging in to hold his only threat at bay to the line. IN TODD WE TRUST three wide in close range, was the outermost of a trio heads apart when roused at the five-sixteenths, cornered from just off the inside into the stretch, rallied mildly until getting on track in the final furlong, surged late to close ground inside the final sixteenth but it proved not enough while well clear for the place. A. M. MAYHEM three to four wide towards the rear, came under a prolonged drive from the seven-sixteenths, rallied mildly by mostly tired foes to procure the show while never a threat to the top pair. THUNDER BUT NORAIN attended the pace from just off the inside, came under urging at the three-eighths pole vying for command between rivals to the quarter pole, cut the corner vacated by STICK TO YOUR GUNS backing out and tired in the stretch. STICK TO YOUR GUNS hustled from the gate, set the pace inside, got engaged by a pair nearing the three-eighths pole, was roused at the station in response, began to retreat nearing the quarter pole, cut the corner into the lane and folded. LIKE A BOSS saved ground through the first turn, settled three wide between rivals towards the rear, began to lose ground when placed to a long drive from the seven-sixteenths, got detached from the main body of the field through the turn and was not persevered with in the stretch.
