Footnotes

In a race when none of the participants got off cleanly, HOT HEIR SKIER was bumped from both sides at the start, moved up to latch on to the runner up, disputed the pace from between opponents during the run around the bend, got asked for some run after the half had been completed, worked his way to the front during the ensuing furlong while drifting outward, ducked in sharply, displaying some green ness, just as the rider prepared to use the stick from the right side in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, proceeded to race erratically the remainder of the way to the wire, reaching it just in time to preserve the decision. OLIVER ZIP bobbed at the break, found himself on the lead nonetheless and was rapidly placed along the inside route, was under a drive on the turn, getting hounded by another pair parked to his outside, yielded to the winner in upper stretch, staged a mild comeback to cut into that one's margin in the late stages. CHARLEYMILLIONAIRE lightly bumped very shortly after the start, raced from off the inside, was two wide entering the turn and in the six path settling into upper stretch, got straightened away, gained good ground in the final furlong, appearing to be the one with the best late foot. PAX ORBIS was steadied and pulled away from the runner up after making contact right after the start, raced two wide and from between rivals on the turn, lacked the needed stretch response. CAVU got squeezed after getting bumped at the start, departed the backstretch three wide, commenced the stretch from the five path, had no rally. OTOY broke inward, initiating contact with the nearest opponent, secured a forward position, disputed the pace three wide and as the widest of a threesome, needed strong handling by the five-sixteenths pole to keep pace, gave way soon afterwards. EYE LUV LULU broke outward, bumping with PAX ORBIS and leading that opponent to get steadied and taken outward, rode the rail tracking a three-way pace fight, faltered.
