PASS THE COFFEE tracked a pace dispute along the inside in range, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, got angled three to four wide into upper stretch, rallied into contention a furlong out rolling by inside the eighth pole to draw clear in the final furlong and prevail. GABRIEL'S FLAME four wide in aim off a pace dispute, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide for home into prominence, got bumped when taking narrow command at the three-sixteenths as TELEVISION TOO shied out under near sided stick work bumping CUCKOO HOUSE between rivals into him, dug in clinging to a slim lead a furlong out, got overhauled inside the eighth pole, fought on mildly to the end and just hung on for the place. CUCKOO HOUSE came in at the start bumping solidly with SHYLOCK who came out at the start forcing both GRACE'S HONOR and BRILLIANT EINSTEIN to be steadied in hand at the break, prompted the pace three wide down the backside before inching a bit closer to vie for command nearing the head of the lane, came in slightly cornering for home as TELEVISION TOO drifted out slightly to his inside forcing the rival JOHNNY STAR between those foes to steady at the quarter pole and get squeezed out, battled head to head with that inside rival and was headed in tandem at the three-sixteenths when TELEVISION TOO drifted out slightly under near sided stick work bumping him lightly into GABRIEL'S FLAME, battled on through to the wire mildly with that foe and just missed for the place. TELEVISION TOO coaxed on the pace inside pressured by a trio to the three-eighths pole when placed to urging, continued along the inside under threat by a pair, came out slightly at the quarter pole squeezing JOHNNY STAR out between foes in tandem with CUCKOO HOUSE who came in slightly, fought head to head coming under near sided stick work and shied outwards bumping that same foe into the new leader GABRIEL'S FLAME at the three-sixteenths, kept on to the eighth pole before weakening in the late stages. SHYLOCK came out at the start bumping solidly with CUCKOO HOUSE forcing GRACE'S HONOR and BRILLIANT EINSTEIN to steady in behind that collision, pressed the pace three wide between foes to the three-eighths when his path was tightened up and he was squeezed out of the fracas up front, got placed to urging at the five-sixteenths and weakened in the stretch. BRILLIANT EINSTEIN steadied at the start when shut off as SHYLOCK and CUCKOO HOUSE collided in front, was outrun early on racing a bit greenly, took the overland route through the turn and made no impact. JOHNNY STAR hustled from the start, pressed the pace from the two path between foes battling among a quartet to the three-eighths, tightened the lane slightly on SHYLOCK forcing that rival to steady briefly out of the pace mix at that station when placed to a ride, battled heads apart arriving to the quarter pole when put in tight himself as foes on each side came over slightly, was forced to steady when squeezed out at that juncture and weakened to the wire. GRACE'S HONOR a bit fractious in the gate leaping up prior to the break, got steadied at the start when SHYLOCK and CUCKOO HOUSE collided in front, grew rank under the restraint proceeding to buck rodeo style for a few strides turned

sideways to the rail, was pulled up and subsequently walked off with an escort by outrider. There was a Stewards' Inquiry into the start of the race focusing on GRACE'S HONOR before the result was declared official.
