PATRIOTIC DUTY was primarily four wide on the turn, got put to urging and advanced steadily into contention with a run starting from past the three-eighths pole, battled as the widest of three from upper to midstretch, left the eighth pole locked up a duel with the runner up, won that fight after racing on nearly even terms for another sixteenth, then edged away, kept to a drive. BROADWAY HAT was taken hold after being bumped at the start, took up position in the three path, sat patiently there for more than halfway around the turn, moved up when ready as the field neared the quarter pole and was given his cue, fought with vigor from between rivals for most of the way through the furlong grounds, went head to head with the winner thereafter until the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, fell back slightly, but kept going in a willing manner to secure second. SINCITYEDDIE bobbed outward, making some contact with the runner up as a result, moved up to become the primary pursuer, stalked the energetically-handled pacesetter, rider atop with a firm grip on the reins, from the two path, ranged up leaving the five-sixteenths pole and appeared to poke a head down in front a sixteenth later, came under heavy assault soon afterwards, fought well with that pair until midstretch, then backed away. WOBURN was brushed a short distance out of the starting gate, dashed over to the rail and made it over there well before reaching the end of the backstretch, took the inside route on the turn, doing so under some hand encouragement, picked up the pace coming to the quarter pole, got checked when bottled up in traffic from that station until upper stretch, never regained any real interest. GET OFF THE STOOP squeezed at the start, swung four wide into upper stretch, had no rally. RIDE'EM COWBOY was used from the gate to grab the early advantage, had a host of rivals close in approaching the quarter pole, relinquished readily and retreated.
