Footnotes

BLONDECAT prompted the pacesetter from the two path, coaxed along while doing so, moved up to increase the pressure coming to the top of the lane, was a short distance into the stretch drive before getting asked for a response, put away the leader readily after having done so, increased the winning margin, kept busy to the end. STELLALUCE saved ground throughout, had sufficient clearance at the three-sixteenths pole to launch a rail rally after ABA DABBLER had drifted out slightly at that point, got outfinished instead. ABA DABBLER showed the way from the inside, pressed by two others for the opening half, got called upon a couple of jumps before arriving at the quarter pole, relinquished soon afterwards. SHEA GOODBYE three wide entering the turn, was four wide exiting it, lacked a solid closing punch. BEPPJ saved ground for nearly a half, was under constant urging during the run around the bend, swung outward until five wide by the top of the lane, went by weak and tired ones after being straightened away. MON ROSE broke last, failed to pick it up despite being put to strong hand encouragement for half the distance down the backstretch. HOOK IT UP was steadied after the start, as ABA DABBLER was migrating her way over towards the inside, gave chase from the outside and tired. NIKKI'S NUT sat forwardly placed in the early going, left the five-sixteenths pole from three path being roused, folded.
