Footnotes

GRACE'S NEH NEH put to a firm hold shortly after leaving the starting gate, contently tracked the pacesetter from the inside for the opening three-quarters, was asked for a response angling outward past the midway point on the far turn, needed only several strides to latch on to SIMPLISTIC and initiate a prolonged duel, took over the lead and gradually drew clear, fed a steady diet of solid right handed shots in the late stages to maintain a straight course. SIMPLISTIC lunged inward in an awkward manner at the start, hitting the gate, yet managed to outbreak all but one rival, quickly assumed the lead and was guided over to the inside, cut the pace, being rated and being accompanied by an equally-rated LOUDER THAN SOUND just to the outside, had that rival drop back slightly soon after reaching the far turn, gained no respite as the eventual winner pounced upon him as the third fraction was being recorded, remained in a tussle that lasted from that juncture to the end, yielded and continued to fall back grudgingly thereafter. GOLDEN CHEETAH three wide around both turns, proved no match. LOUDER THAN SOUND got carried inward slightly by the runner up leaving the starting gate, was rated in the two path prompting the leader until the top of the far turn, got shaken off shortly afterwards and folded. NEW DOO was strung out four wide until the crown of the far turn, remained well inside throughout the running and offered no serious bids. LOVE IS KEY KAZ raced along the outside and was outrun. SILVER MAST tossed her head and got away slowly, saved ground until upper stretch while trailing.
