SCHILLERETTE five wide down the backside towards the rear, progressed into mid pack by the seven-sixteenths, made a four wide bid under urging on the front to seize command at the quarter pole, drew clear under a drive then was placed to a hand ride through the final sixteenth to prevail comfortably. MOTION LOUNGE two to three wide in mid pack, came under urging to get more involved at the seven-sixteenths, moved into contention swinging three wide at the quarter pole, proved no match for the top one offering up a mild kick to be clear for the place honors. SUGAR BEACH broke out at the start and was corrected, settled just off the pace tracking from the three path, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, spun five wide in upper stretch, offered up a mild bid to secure the show by mostly tired rivals. ROYAL SUSPICION saved ground towards the rear, came under a ride three furlongs out and passed tired rivals in the stretch. EVAN'S ROCKET settled in mid pack four wide, came under a ride midway on the turn, spun four wide for home and offered no response. MARY P. JONES dueled inside from the get go, got let out at the five-sixteenths as the pressure intensified, was overhauled at the quarter pole and steadily weakened in the stretch. PENNYMINE dueled two to three wide, got spirited up at the five-sixteenths, retreated nearing the quarter pole, spun four wide at that station and gave way. G. A. EMPRESS off a beat slow, was outrun early on, got detached halfway from the main body of the field while trailing throughout.
