JESTER RAHAB was outrun early, advanced inside on the turn, found room on the rail in the stretch, dug in resolutely and prevailed after a hard drive. CATIVA raced close up inside early, came wide into the stretch and finished gamely outside. FEATHER BOA quickly showed in front, set the pace and dug in gamely in the stretch. LAVENDER LASS was in hand early, came wide for the drive and finished well outside. SEEKING THE SILVER chased the pace from the outside and tired in the final furlong. ANYPLACE ANYTIME raced four wide and tired. SOUTHERN SMOKE tired after a half mile. WILD PUNCH broke awkwardly, raced wide and tired.
