NEW YORK STYLE quickly cleared the competition to take command, cut the pace from the inside, shrugged off a brief challenge from the runner up nearing the end of the run down the backstretch, then drew away throughout the stretch drive under steady encouragement. MARINA MARKET chased the pacesetter from the outside, made a brief run at the leader nearing the far turn, failed to keep pace, despite being set down in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, but was still good enough to take the place. ONE STARRY NITE rank early, adjusting to the rating tactics being applied by the rider, settled down before reaching the backstretch, tracked the front runner from afar, while kept in reserve, was asked to pick up the pace nearing midpoint on the far turn, angled four wide into the stretch and was along in time for the show. COALTOWN LEGEND unhurried for nearly three-quarters, settled into the five path at the head of the stretch, and was never a menace. THREE IN THE BAG three to four wide around each turn, tired. RISES THE PHOENIX was taken in hand, between rivals and just to the outside of a rank ONE STARRY NITE about midway on the opening bend, proceeded towards the three path heading for the backstretch, gradually worked his way over to the inside, tucking along the rail at the five-sixteenths pole and steadily tired thereafter. LARRY'S FORTY TWO trailed throughout.
