Footnotes

CALIBRACHOA bumped lightly with TEMECULA CREEK after bobbling at the start, took up a forward position tracking the pacesetter from off the inside, remained on hold for nearly the opening half, responded willingly when asked in upper stretch, was carried out a path or two by FASTUS CACTUS during the latter portion of the run through the furlong grounds, continued onward, narrowing in readily on the front runners at the eighth pole, once safely by the errant FASTUS CACTUS, battled hard, forging to the front in the final seventy yards and edged clear under good handling. INDEPENDENCE WAR stalked the pacesetter from the outside under a good hold, took off in earnest when given his cue in upper stretch, angled out a bit leaving the three-sixteenths pole, to split rivals, grabbed the narrowest of edges just past the eighth pole, dug in stubbornly, reluctantly yielded in deep stretch but finished with good courage nonetheless to garner the place. TEMECULA CREEK bumped lightly with the top one at the start, sat reserved in the three path for nearly a half, gained readily when called upon after turning for home, was taken in hand and altered course sharply outward to clear a pair of drifting opponents approaching the furlong marker, got going again in short order and came home with good late foot en route for the show. ENDLESS CIRCLE took the inside route, was coaxed along to keep pace at the three-eighths pole, went on with a mild rail rally to assume command at the eighth pole but soon flattened out. FASTUS CACTUS broke running, was placed under a strong hold after immediately trying to bear out, was well out in the middle of the track most of the way down the backstretch, despite the best efforts of the rider, continued the fight against the jockey, but was expertly guided into the three path in time for the run around the bend, felt some pressure heading for the stretch, drifted out a bit in upper stretch, carrying out the top one a bit as a result, tired steadily during final furlong.
