CARMELLA CEE chased three wide, was put to encouragement at the five-sixteenths pole, spun from the four path into the lane, made little progress during the initial portion of the stretch drive, shadowing WOW ME a few paths closer to the apron, picked up the pace when the aforementioned rival went about on a straighter course, coming to the eighth pole, gained readily on the runner up, rolling by under confident handling in the final strides to prove best. FIDDLERS DIVA established control soon after the start, set the pace, placed slightly off the rail, turned for home holding a clear advantage and got asked for a response, felt the top one's presence a short distance past the furlong grounds, got overhauled in the late stages and had to settle for the place. WOW ME exchanged several light bumps with DEPUTY'S CITIZEN just after the break, departed the backstretch three wide and took up the pursuit from there, was asked for some run in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole and began to pick up interest, drifted off slightly from upper to midstretch, tempering the eventual winner's momentum as a result, ran on a truer course for the last eighth and flattened out. DEPUTY'S CITIZEN was taken hold after trading bumps with WOW ME in rapid succession about two jumps out of the starting gate, lagged at the back of the pack from the outside for nearly a half, was put to encouragement turning for home and mustered up a mild stretch response to grab the last major check. BUDDY SYSTEM raced along the outside and improved position. IN HER HEY DAY three wide, failed to reach a contending position. WISEMAN'S JET stumbled at the start, recovered and took up a forward post, chased from the two path, albeit never applying serious pressure on the pacesetter and tired. CHAKA BWANA took the inside route, angled off the rail for the stretch run, was tiring when the rider lost the whip in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole.
