### Footnotes

MY ANGUILLA pressed the pace from outside into upper stretch, surged to the front leaving the furlong marker and prevailed after a long hard drive. STUNNING ELECTRA rushed up on the rail, dueled inside the winner into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. GLORY GOLD raced in traffic between horses along the backstretch, rallied inside on the turn, angled out in upper stretch and finished willingly. GOLD FOR THE QUEEN steadied briefly in the early stages, checked in traffic at the half mile pole, chased just off the pace three wide into upper stretch and weakened. WHEELS UP steadied and angled in while trailing on the far turn, saved ground for half, swung out and lacked a rally. TOMORROWS ROSES showed early speed along the rail and gave way midway on the turn.
