OLD GUYS RULE off to a quick start, showed the way towards the inside, was challenged by a pair of rivals from three-eighths pole to the quarter pole, shook free when asked for run during the ensuing furlong and held safely while being kept busy. GREY FOOSE left the backstretch three wide, moved in tandem with SAY GOODBYE to take on the leader approaching the three-eighths pole, proved to be not up for the task, losing contact with the top one after entering the stretch, but continued onward with good courage to garner the place. SAY GOODBYE forwardly placed down the backstretch, disputed the pace between rivals from midway on the turn to the quarter pole then got outkicked. CELLA MUFFLER off the inside, never threatened. ROCK SUPERSTAR faded off a ground-saving ground. ROARING SEASONS was grabbed hold of after ducking inward at the start, fell back in a hurry, and was eased turning for home.
